Our number of the week will be 3. We will be looking at number recognition and representing 3 using both objects and mark-making.

Our book of the week will be "We're going on a bear hunt". We went for a lovely walk in the woods and intend to do the same again this week as both the children and adults enjoyed it so much, so this seemed the perfect book for the week ahead.
